# EDAA Lifetime Achievement Award 2012

In 2012, the European Design and Automation Association (EDAA) will grant the tenth EDAA Lifetime Achievement Award.

### Scope and Goals

The lifetime achievement award shall be given to individuals who made outstanding contributions to the state of the art in electronic design, electronic design automation and testing of electronic systems in their life.

In order to be eligible, candidates must have made innovative contributions which had an impact on the way electronic systems are being designed.

The goal of granting the award is to make the excellent work done by people working within the scope described above more widely known and to help to publicize the results.

### Nomination

Nominations should be sent to the Chair of EDAA, Norbert WEHN, by **October 14, 2011**. Nominations should include a 2-3 page appraisal of the candidate's work.

In order to identify the best candidate for the EDAA Lifetime Achievement Award, a committee will evaluate the proposals. This committee consists of individuals representing the scope of the call. If necessary, external experts can be asked to provide a written evaluation of a certain candidate.
